

Key performance highlights for Kriti Arogya Kendram for the month of January 2010:

Eye Care

- In January, our eye care screenings with LV Prasad Eye Institute and VisionSpring picked up pace. The following table summarises our eye care activity for the month of January and till date:

Pregnant Women Training

- In January, we extended the coverage of the ante-natal care training to three more bastis. With this, we have now covered 8 of 16 bastis in Film Nagar, and reached over 60 expectant mothers. The screenings of last month resulted in identifying 2 HbSAg positive women (that is tested positive for Hepatitis B). We are trying to assist the women and their families through the issues related to further care.

Other Developments

- On February 3, we shifted the clinic to new premises within the basti. This new location is relatively more visible and easily accessible to the community.
- We have engaged Dr. Srikrishna, a Paediatrician working with Mahavir Hospital, to visit our health centre once a week. He will start mid-February.
- We have started a process of discussions with the registered medical practitioners (unqualified health providers) in the basti, to find ways to engage with them to provide better services to the larger basti. By providing some basic training to the RMPs and by sharing our provider network with them, we will be able to improve the overall quality of primary healthcare in the community and thus have a greater social impact.
